## Our main programs:

Organizing Educational Seminars for the Protection of the Marine Ecosystem

In our educational seminars, we transfer the knowledge that the All For Blue team has gained through years of action, both beneath the sea's surface and on the shores, in an experiential way. Through our experiences, we become the "eyes" that allow participants to discover the magic of the oceans and understand the importance of protecting them. The seminar topics highlight the value of protecting and properly managing the marine ecosystem, aiming to convey fundamental concepts such as "sustainable management" and "sustainability." At the same time, we provide practical guidance, encouraging participants to actively contribute to preserving the marine environment. Particular emphasis is placed on the importance of reducing plastic use, promoting a responsible, environmentally conscious lifestyle.

## Hands-on Beach and Underwater Cleanup Activities

Through beach and underwater cleanups, we promote cooperation and teamwork. Our goal is to educate participants on organizing and executing beach cleanups, strengthen collective action, and raise awareness about the protection of the seas. Following the zero environmental footprint protocol applied to our actions, our volunteers use All For Blue's reusable equipment. The underwater cleanups are conducted by certified divers, while the waste collected is weighed and categorized by material type in a global database. This process contributes to the collection and analysis of critical environmental data to monitor marine pollution and develop strategies for protecting marine waters.

## Circular Economy - Giving Waste a New Life

One of the fundamental principles of the circular economy is the reuse of items. The plastic waste collected from the seabed and beaches is processed, cleaned, and transformed into building materials that are then used to construct recycling bins. Through this process, plastic waste returns to the local community in the form of practical items, demonstrating that every product at the end of its useful life can be repurposed. In this way, we showcase the potential for material reuse, promoting sustainability and reducing the environmental footprint.





### Educational Missions Abroad

All For Blue operates with a vision to spread the values of volunteerism and contribution to as many regions of the world as possible. Through our actions, we bring together people from diverse backgrounds and cultures to serve a common purpose. In 2023, volunteers from our team with varying levels of experience and familiarity with the sea embarked on a journey to three local islands in the Maldives. During our mission, we organized educational seminars and beach cleanups in collaboration with 1,000 students, thereby enhancing their environmental awareness. A love for the sea, the underwater world, and its marine creatures, combined with a sense of contribution and solidarity, was the driving force behind the success of this mission.

## Art Competitions with Creations from Waste Collected by Students


